Feedback Action Taken report

Indira Mahavidyalaya, Kalamb Dist. Yavatmal has systemic mechanism for feedback from students, teachers and other stakeholders on curriculum related institutional processes. The ultimate aim of stakeholder's feedback is to get useful insights for the purpose of improvement in all aspects of teaching, learning, assessment capacity and infrastructural needs. Curriculum delivery, being one of the significant aspects of the teaching learning process, needs continuous and periodical evaluation. The process of development of curriculum is presented below

After the complete analysis of the feedback, changes are suggested by IQAC and to the respective departments and faculty. On the recommendations, the needful changes are incorporated.

The institution is using the students' feedback as a base to make improvements in the existing system after reviewing and analyzing it carefully. The students' feedback questionnaire encompasses quantitative and qualitative answers focused on the quality of the in-course content, pedagogy, learning material, views about theory/practical courses, and services extended to them by the institute.

Continuous improvement in the scheme has shown positive feedback by the students. Content of the course and conduct of theory and practical courses project work have gained the interest of most of the students. The syllabus, instruction plans, and lab handling were informed as per curriculum schemes. They are satisfied with conduction of guest lectures and workshops and other interdepartmental activities etc. during the session.

Significant improvements and increments are made as follows:

Institute has also procured online mode of teaching wherever possible in which the most syllabus topics are discussed sophistically.

- New Lab was constructed and it made to use from session 2022-23.
- Workshops on "Administrative Quality Enhancement" for supporting staff were organized by IQAC in session.
- M.Sc. (Chemistry), M.A. (Geography) & M.A. (Economics) courses were started from session 2022-23.

Alumni
